What NOT to Wear

Go dressed more formally than what would be expected on the job. Clarify preferred attire if you're in doubt.





Analyze the Job Description

Compare their description with YOUR skills, knowledge, and experience.

ID points of CONNECTION.



4 things you have to know:

- Your strengths & weaknesses as they relate to the position- -Why you want to work for the company
- What you want to ask themHow you will answer, "Tell me about yourself"



Do your RESEARCH

- Review their website
- Be familiar with their business focus, values & culture, locations
- Think about the ways YOU match THEIR needs, weave this into your examples
- Show interest in what they do



Types of Questions

- Behavioral: "Give me an example..." use the STAR method, describe Situation/Task, your Action, & Result
- Traditional: Baséd on your resume and general fit with company Technical: Used to determine your core knowledge of a technical area & how you solve problems - thinking out loud is key!
